Pa'tothom invites top international experts to Barcelona in search of innovative teaching lines in the field of theater for social intervention

Barcelona, 12/01/12. The Forn de Teatre Pa'tothom, has launched today a plan of work that will face all year to renew their pedagogical lines are designed to foster critical thinking at a time of creative, in areas such as domestic violence, legislation, media, promoting a broader understanding of the environment being so thoughtful individuals as well as artists.

To implement these curricular goals with experts from various fields of Theatre of the Oppressed. The program will start in February with the presence of Muriel Naessens from France, who has 30 years of experience in the field of gender violence, sexism, prevention, and come to work the construction of the female, the male and inequality with the theater. The academic program based on the experience of 11 years, aims to promote the skills to be acquired by the individual, and comes from the research in the participant's interests and later developing a program to support and expand these interests, so they can expand their knowledge in understanding and solving problems. These range are from gender, law to media.

Pa'tothom was the first institution in Spain that teaches Theatre of the Oppressed, and is in constant search of teaching methodologies that are consistent with the specific challenges of today in the field of social theater: Lack of renewal in the field of theater pedagogy and poor quality in implementing it in different areas. Pa'tothom, has launched this plan of work that will last throughout 2012.
